Content

The course includes theoretical lectures and hands-on workshops where students will learn basic skills to develop their own artistic/design e-textiles projects.

In lectures, theoretical frameworks as well as previous projects done in the fields of wearable technology art, e-textiles and critical design are introduced by various experts.

In workshops, the practical skills necessary for e-textiles project development, such as electronics is introduced as hands-on sessions

Learning Outcomes

The course aims to:

- Give students an overview of e-textiles practices including theoretical frameworks, as well as previous works done in the field.
- Support students to critically reflect on their conceptual themes, theoretical frameworks and design expressions in their own e-textiles projects.
- Equip students with basic skills and knowledge of e-textile practices such as electronics, programming and e-textiles specific material knowledge as medium of expression.

After completing the course students shall be able to:

- Plan a design process and the workflow of their own e-textiles projects and develop prototypes/proof of concepts on their own.
- Demonstrate an ability to express their artistic/design concepts through the use of e-textiles, and be able to critically discuss their work.

Forms of Teaching

Lectures, seminars, workshops.

The language of instruction is English.
