Content

Demonstration of and training in:

- the most common single and double bed knitting techniques.
- basic tricot technology for weft knitting machines, circular knitting and flat knitting.

Review of:

- Environmental and quality aspects of tricot production.
- Theory of tricot machines and tricot goods.
- Development trends within the design of goods for weft knitting and weft knitting machines.

Experimental training and development of:

- technique-based research in tricot and knitting.
- different techniques and structures
- basic design concepts

Learning Outcomes

The course aims to develop students' artistic ability within tricot and knitting through technical training and experimental investigation of the expressive and functional opportunities offered by different techniques. After completing and passing the course, students at first-cycle level should:

- be able to carry out and run their own experimental design work in hand knitting and industrial knitting.
- have basic knowledge about tricot technology, weaving theory and tricot materials.
- have knowledge about the structure and construction of knitted fabrics.

The main focus of the course is on learning outcomes: 2a-b, 4a-b, 6a-b.

Forms of Teaching

Tuition consists of lectures, exercises and laboratory work.

Forms of Examination

The course will be examined through the following examination elements

- Documented presentation of independent creative work, 5,5 credits, Grading scale: Fail (U)/Pass (G)
- Written exam, 2,0 credits, Grading scale: Fail (U)/Pass (G)
