Content

This course includes theoretical and practical experimental artistic work where students will develop individual artistic projects. In lectures, workshops and seminars, students will study, work on and discuss both their own artistic ideas and methods and ideas in the field of other contemporary art and design. Various works in the field of art and design, current exhibitions and art and design-related literature are used as a knowledge base.

Learning Outcomes

This course aims:

- To give students the opportunity to work both visually and verbally on advanced artistic issues relating to design so as to be able consequently to develop their own personal artistic ability.
- To develop and enhance students' ability to reflect on, describe and present their artistic processes in a design context.

Once the course has been passed, students should be able:

- To demonstrate functioning methods relating to how they systematically develop and underpin their artistic concepts, corresponding to different aspects of design practice.
- To demonstrate an ability to relate their individual artistic concepts to already existing art and design works, as well as to relevant literature.

Forms of Teaching

Lectures, seminars, workshops and study visits.

Teaching will take place through the medium of English.

The language of instruction is English.

Forms of Examination

The course will be examined through the following examination elements:

Active participation in lectures, seminars and workshops Learning outcomes: Credits: 1.5 Gradingscale: Fail (U) or Pass (G)

Written report including pictures Learning outcomes: Credits: 3 Gradingscale: Fail (U) or Pass (G)

Visual & oral presentation, ind. project Learning outcomes: Credits: 3 Gradingscale: Fail (U) or Pass (G)

Each exam will be offered five times, including three in the space of one year. With the offer of an examination session is meant scheduled exam or resit an alternative date for written or oral presentations.
